The 26th Annual Bellbrook MSBA Band Invitational will be held on Saturday, Sept. 13, 2014, at Miami Valley South Stadium at Bellbrook High School. Performances begin at 5 p.m. and conclude at 9 p.m. with the exhibition performance from The University of Toledo Rocket Marching Band. Awards follow at 9:30 p.m.

Bellbrook High School is located at 3757 Upper Bellbrook Road, Bellbrook, Ohio 45305

Tickets

General admission tickets are priced at \$9; youth under 10 and seniors over 61 are priced at \$6; children 3-and-under are free.

Ticket booths are located on the main entrance and the north side of the stadium. Each paid admission will receive a wristband to allow access to the stadium. Please note there are no refunds on tickets.

Parking

Parking is free and volunteer staff will be present during the event to assist motorists. Please follow signage and instructions from staff members as they guide you to the appropriate parking.

Handicapped parking areas will be designated on asphalt close to the stadium and can be located with the assistance of parking staff. Please have handicapped parking permit sign visible in your vehicle window to help the parking staff.

Entrance and seating

The spectator entrances are located on the north and west sides of the stadium. Gates will be open approximately one hour before the first performance.

All tickets will be issued as general admission and be used on the home (west) side of the field. Bands that have performed will be allowed to sit on the visitor (east) side of the stadium.

As a courtesy to our guest bands, movement to and from the seating areas will be limited during performances. Ushers will restrict spectators from entering the seating area while bands are performing.

Concessions

Concessions will be available throughout the day. A variety of hot and cold foods items and drinks will be offered at reasonable prices.
